III. Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 Yangon Arrival

Arrive in Yangon where you will be welcomed by your local tour guide and transferred to your hotel to drop off your luggage. Free for personal activities. Overnight in Yangon.

Day 2 Yangon Sight - Seeing

After breakfast, morning sightseeing starting with World famous Shwedagon Pagoda, Karaweik Hall Royal barge on the Royal lake for photo stop, Yangon's city center featuring Sule Pagoda and colonial building. Evening free for leisure and overnight at hotel in Yangon.

Day 3 Yangon - Mandalay

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for Mandalay, Upon arrival in Mandalay and check in to hotel and Mandalay full day sightseeing; visit to Mahamuni Pagoda, Kyauktawgyi Pagoda a large Buddha image carved out of a single block of marble, Shwenandaw Monastery (Golden Palace) noted for its exquisite wood carving, Kuthodaw Pagoda known as the world's Biggest Book for its stone slabs of Buddhist scriptures. Mandalay Palace and in the afternoon to observe the Gold leaf beating, Stone carving, Wood carving and Tapestry and enjoy the sunset from Mandalay Hill. Overnight at hotel in Mandalay.

Day 4 **Mandalay - Amarapura - Mingun**

After breakfast at hotel, Proceed to Amarapura visit to Mahagandayon Monastery, observe Myanmar Traditional Hand-Woven silk workshop, visit to Mahagandayon Monastery, enjoy beautiful scenery at U Bein Bridge. In the afternoon depart from Mandalay on a private boat along the Ayeyarwaddy River to visit Mingun, a village on the west bank of the river. Visit to Mingun Pahtotawgyi, the world renowned ringing Mingun Bell and beautiful Myatheintan Pagoda. enjoy sunset by boat in beautiful scenery at Ayeyarwaddy River. Drive back to Mandalay and overnight.

Day 5 **Mandalay - Mon Ywa**

After breakfast at hotel, Morning drive to Monywa and sightseeing includes Thanboddhay Paya (with 500,000 of Buddha images); Po Khaung Taung; Aung Sakkyia Pagoda and view of 300 ft long Reclining Buddha. Cross the Chindwin River and visit to Shwe Ba Hill and Phowin Taung caves. Back to hotel and overnight in Monywa..

Day 6 **MonYwa - Sagaing - Mandalay**

After breakfast at hotel, drive to Mandalay on route visit to Sagaing Hill , which is perhaps the living centre of Buddhist faith in Myanmar today. Hillsides are dotted with numerous Pagodas and Monasteries. enjoy the charming view from saging hill. and then Proceed to bronze casting, silver casting; in the afternoon drive back to Mandalay...

Day 7 **Mandalay – Bagan by RV Shwe Keinnery Cruise**

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to jetty to take the cruise to Bagan along the river Ayeyarwaddy sampling some of the village life of the people on the river banks. In the evening, arrive at Bagan and transfer to hotel. Overnight at hotel in Bagan.

Day 8 **Bagan full day sightseeing**

After breakfast at hotel, Bagan sightseeing includes; the colorful Nyaung U Market, Shwezigon Pagoda and its magnificent golden sputa, Htilominlo Temple noted for its fine plaster carvings and glazed sand

stone decoration. Visit to Myinkaba Village to observe the process of Traditional Lacquarware Industry one of Myanmar's best-known handicrafts. In the evening visit to Ananda Temple, an architectural masterpiece of the early-style temple with four impressive standing Buddha images. Enjoy sunset over the site from the upper terrace of Shwesandaw Pagoda. Overnight at hotel in Bagan.

Day 9 Bagan full day sightseeing

After breakfast at hotel, second day of Bagan sightseeing start with Lawkananda Pagoda; East and West Phet Leik with clay plaque Jataka scenes; Thatbyinnyu Temple; Shwegugyi Temple; Palace site and Tharaba Gate. Tour includes Apeyadana Temple with the paintings of Mahayana concept; Nagayon Temple; Archaeological Museum; Dhamayangyi Temple, a massive Temple with finest brick work and Mingalar Zedi, Bu Paya to watch sunset over the Ayeyarwaddy River. Overnight at hotel in Bagan.

Day 10 Bagan - Heho - Inle Lake

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for flight to Heho. Proceed to Inle Lake. Visiting Phaung Daw Oo Pagoda, Floating Gardens, Unique Leg-rowers, Traditional Fishing Method Stilt House Villages on the lake and Nge Pe Chaung (Jamping Cat) Monastery. Overnight at hotel in Inle Lake.

Day 11 Inle Lake – Indein sightseeing

After breakfast at hotel, Visit to Indein, ancient pagodas, Shan Cheroot making, free for leisure in Inle Lake. Overnight in Inle Lake.

Day 12 Inle -Yangon

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to Heho Airport for flight to Yangon. Arrive Yangon and transfer to hotel. Free at leisure. Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

Day 13 Yangon – Bago – Yangon

After breakfast at hotel, Day return sightseeing trip to Bago. Visit to Kyaikpon four seated Buddha Images. Kyakhatwine Monastery, where a thousand of monks who take their last meal of the day at 10 am in total silence, Kanbawza Thardi Palace built by King Bayinnaung, Kalayani Sima (Ordination Hall),

Shwemawdaw Pagoda, Shwethalyaung Pagoda, the world's most beautiful reclining Buddha, Wood Carving Industry and Bago local Market. Visit enroute World War II Allied War Grave Cemetery near Taukkyant. Drive back to Yangon. Overnight at hotel in Yangon.

Day 14 Yangon Departure

After breakfast at hotel, you will be transferred to Yangon International airport for your return international departure flight. Tour ends.

IV. Terms & Conditions

GENERAL BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS

BOOKING PROCEDURE

- E-Travel Myanmar required deposit of at least 30% of total tour cost to guarantee the booking. This amount can be paid by credit card (through a secured payment system), bank transfer, Western Union or Paypal.
- Remainder of total tour cost must be paid in cash upon arrival or 2 weeks before departure date if by any other payment methods.
- Transfer fee, if any, must be paid at customer's end. E-Travel Myanmar will recognize the amount received only.

CANCELLATION

At E-Travel Myanmar Co.,Ltd, we do our best to minimize cancellation penalty for our guests but we must abide the cancellation policy of each service provider. Any cancellations should be made in writing.

Cancellation by the customers

Where the Customer cancels the tour, then the effective date of cancellation will be the date the company receives the written notification. The cancellation charge to the customer is listed below:

- More than 30 days before departure :deposit if forfeited
- Between 15 and 29 days before departure :50 % of total tour cost
- Between 7 days and 14 days before departure :70 % of total tour cost
- Between 2 days and 6 days before departure :85 % of total tour cost
- 1 day or less :100 % of total tour cost
- Flight tickets are fixed following the final itinerary, 100% charge for airfare for any cancellation.

Cancellation by E-Travel Myanmar

If tour is not paid by the due date, the company shall have the right to cancel the tour. If we, at the request of the customer, agrees to delay cancellation of the tour then the company still cancels the tour for the customer's non-payment, the cancellation charges set out shall apply and be payable by the customer.

Special conditions

E-Travel Myanmar reserves the right to change these cancellation conditions depending on airlines, hotels and cruises' cancellation policies. We will inform you in writing in case the above conditions need to be modified.

RESPONSIBILITY
